

## **6th Grade Supply List 2018 – 2019**

### **Classroom supplies:**

- \_\_\_ 3 – boxes of tissues
- \_\_\_ 2 – rolls of paper towels
- \_\_\_ 1 – container antibacterial wipes
- \_\_\_ 1 – (4+) pack dry erase markers (low odor)

### **If your last name starts with A-M**

- \_\_\_ 2 – boxes of non-latex gloves
- \_\_\_ 1 - ADDITIONAL pack of dry erase markers

### **If your last name starts with N-Z**

- \_\_\_ 1 – ADDITIONAL container antibacterial wipes
- \_\_\_ 3 – ADDITIONAL boxes of tissues

### **Personal supplies:**

- \_\_\_ 1 – 4” Binder (If possible, buy a heavy duty one with D-rings...they last longer!)
- \_\_\_ 2 – packs of tab dividers (Students will need between 10 and 16)
- \_\_\_ 6 – pocket folders (preferably vinyl, preferably pre-hole-punched, NO metal brads)
- \_\_\_ 1 – pack of page protectors (10-20 ct)
- \_\_\_ 1 – pencil pouch (with holes to fit in binder, preferably zippered)
- \_\_\_ 1 – pack of colored pencils
- \_\_\_ 1 – pack of cap erasers
- \_\_\_ 1 – pack of highlighters
- \_\_\_ – adequate supply of pencils (if you buy mechanical pencils, you also need lead)
- \_\_\_ 2 – packs of loose-leaf paper (one to be turned in to homeroom teacher)
- \_\_\_ 1 -- earbuds/headphones for use in class
