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Welcome! This is an elective, participation-based class! We are watching for engaged singers! We will do a lot of different activities and assessments, & you are expected to participate to the best of your ability in EVERY CLASS & EVERY PERFORMANCE! It is better to try and fail than to fail to try...Your grade in chorus is an earned one. Remember that much of your grade will be based on your attitude, behavior, attendance in class and at concerts, and how hard you are willing to work for the excellence of our organization.

REQUIRED MATERIALS FOR THIS ELECTIVE CLASS:

- 1. A pencil & 1-subject notebook EVERYDAY. This can be a thin binder with paper, a folder with paper, or composition notebook. Keep everything you do in there until the end of the year.
- 2. Shirt Fee: See prices below & on form (Due Sept13th)

<u>\$11</u> (Adult: Small, medium, large, XL, & Youth: YLarge & Youth XLarge) OR <u>\$13</u> (Adult XXL or XXXL) Once you buy one, you will not have to buy another while at KMS, unless your shirt is messed up (visibly torn, stained, bleached, etc.) or you out-grow it. Trade-outs are sometimes available if you outgrow it. If you have a sibling or family who is a former KMS chorus member (from 2010 and later) – you may use it! This is <u>NOT</u> covered by fee waiver, because you keep it.

3. Chorus Fee: \$20 (Due by Sept 13th) This <u>is</u> covered by fee waiver. This covers music, festival registrations, materials they need for class, some field trip expenses, instruments, & much more! Cash or Check – must be turned in with a labeled envelope!!!!!! *YOU MAY COMBINE YOUR SHIRT FEE & CHORUS FEE:* \$31 or \$33!

CLASSROOM EXPECTATIONS:

1.	Respect Others – Respect their stuff, their feelings, their music
	Be silent when visitors are in the room, the telephone has rung, or announcements are being made
	on the intercom.
2.	Respect the Teacher – Do Not talk or get up without permission.
	Do Not disrupt/interrupt class. Rude behavior, arguing, etc. will not be tolerated.
	Do Not interrupt someone when they are talking. NO HORSEPLAY (automatic write-up)
3.	Respect the Room – No trash on the floor. Pick up after yourself & help others.
	Do not leave your belongings here. (Repeat offenses: Write-up.)
	No gum, food, or drink is allowed in the chorus room.
	Be Careful - Watch where you step!
	Do Not abuse or damage property of the chorus room – music, instruments, risers, chairs, etc.
	The following items are OFF LIMITS to students: teacher's desk, computers, whiteboards,
	stereos, pianos, & keyboard. You will be written up, you'll have to pay for & replace items, &
	Be where you are supposed to be at all times.
4.	Respect Yourself - Participate/Obey teacher's first request - it's the biggest part of your grade! Turn stuff in & keep up with
	due dates, concert dates, and student responsibilities. If you don't know something – please ask!

Concert Attire: Each student must wear the KMS Chorus issued blue polo (Included when you pay your dues) AND khaki colored pants or skirt. (Absolutely No Shorts/Capris!) All items must follow the guidelines of Knox County & KMS dress codes.

-The concert counts as a <u>major</u> test for the semester – it counts as 35% of your grade, daily/rehearsal grade = 65%-Absences are excused only if they are documented & we must have a copy of the excuse on file. (doctor's note, funerals, incidents beyond you and/or your parents' control) Birthdays/parties. Sports games, running out of gas, vacations, etc. are NOT excused. -'Don't have a ride? Let us know ASAP so we might put you in contact with another student/parent! Not having a ride is NOT an excuse. PLAN AHEAD!

-Even if you have an excused absence, you will have to complete an alternative assignment to receive full credit. Unexcused absences cannot be made up.

GRADING POLICY

Along with your performance grades & tests, you will receive a daily participation/activities grade every day (100pts.). Your weekly average will be posted online. If you have trouble following the classroom expectations (below) for participation/performance, this is how we calculate the total :

1st Strike: -10 pts. AND a warning -10 pts.

2nd Strike:

'Unable to improve the situation after a parent phone call? Meeting w/the principal & possible write-up Still unwilling to cooperate & make necessary changes = dismissal from chorus.

FIELD TRIP EXPECTATIONS:

- A field trip permission form will be sent home with a "due date" on it. No permission slips will be accepted after that date - you will NOT go on the field trip. Students are expected to represent the school with respect and dignity when out in public with the KMS Choral Department. Students are expected to stay with the group/teacher at ALL times.

- After School field trips/Pick-Up Policy: This policy is for the student's safety when traveling with the KMS Choral program. Parents must be on time to pick up students after event/trip. If late, the student will not go on the next field trip. Parents must sign the student out IN PERSON before leaving. If student is not signed out by an adult, we will call home ensure safety. A write-up will be completed & the student will not be permitted to go on another after-school trip for the rest of the year.

Opportunities for travel: ETVA Festival, KSO, Musicals, Operas, and plays - as well as performing for community events.

We have also taken trips to see musicals & tours of cities in TN, AND Atlanta, Chicago, Cincinnati, D.C., & St. Louis!
