COURSE DESCRIPTION

This General Music class is designed to help you experiment and discover music in many new and different ways. This is a kinesthetic, participation-based class with lessons that incorporates activities for all types of learners at all different levels of musicianship!

Topics we will explore include reading, playing, and creating music, as well as music history, music genres, music technology, and analyzing music.

MATERIALS NEEDED EVERY DAY

PENCIL, Paper, something to keep your work in (folder or binder)

ASSESSMENT

You are constantly being assessed. Your mastery is shown through performance (musically or verbally), discussion, written & musical composition, attention, and participation.

You must give 100% to get the most out of this class.

Grades you will receive: Project Grades, whole class activities, turn-in assignments, unit quizzes or tests. A Weekly Participation Grade is also given. (the average of each daily grade = weekly Participation Grade)
