What is RTI class?

In order to be fully successful and confident in the academic setting (and in life), students must be able to compute independently and at grade-level. The purpose of this class is to fill in any gaps of the five skill areas necessary for strong mathematics: *number sense, computation, advance computation, geometry, and word problems*. We are using proven, research-validated programs that improve student progress in all five skill areas.

Are you sure this class is for me?

- Students were placed into this intervention program using a number of factors: past TCAP performance, teacher input, past academic performance, and the AimsWeb Screener.
- EVERY KNOX COUNTY STUDENT was administered the STAR test at the end of the last school year. Math and Reading proficiency is assessed through the brief 20-30 minute, computerized assessments.
- The same STAR assessment is administered at the beginning of the school year; this helps us "catch" those students who were not present to take the STAR test last school year but also to confirm the STAR test results of last year's students.

What do Tier 1, Tier 2 and Tier 3 mean to me?

- \succ Tier 1 = student is on grade-level. NO RTI NEEDED.
- ➤ Tier 2= student is 1-2 levels below grade level. RTI IS NEEDED.
- ➤ Tier 3= student is 3 or more levels below grade level. RTI IS NEEDED.

How do I move to a higher Tier?

Moving with Math is a direct instruction component being used with students in Tier 2 and Tier 3 intervention programs. This component will be used daily.

Freckle is a computer component used with students in Tier 2 and Tier 3 intervention programs. <u>THIS COMPONENT CAN BE USED AT HOME.</u> The website is <u>www.freckle.com</u>. This program only works with the Chrome web browser.

Aimsweb is a short, 8-10 minute paper assessment for students in Tier 2 and Tier 3 Intervention. Students will be progress monitored every week or two weeks.
