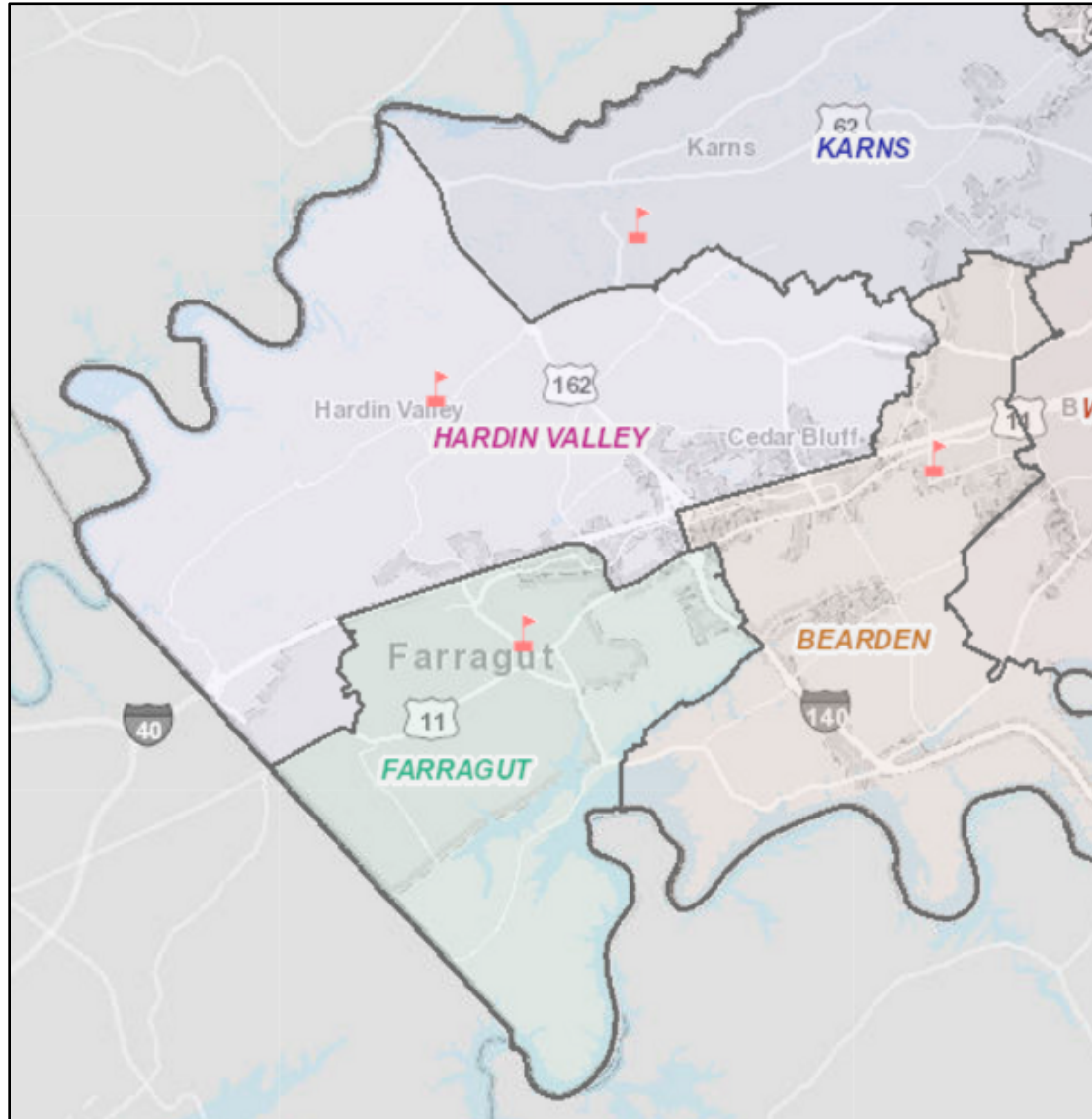

Introduction

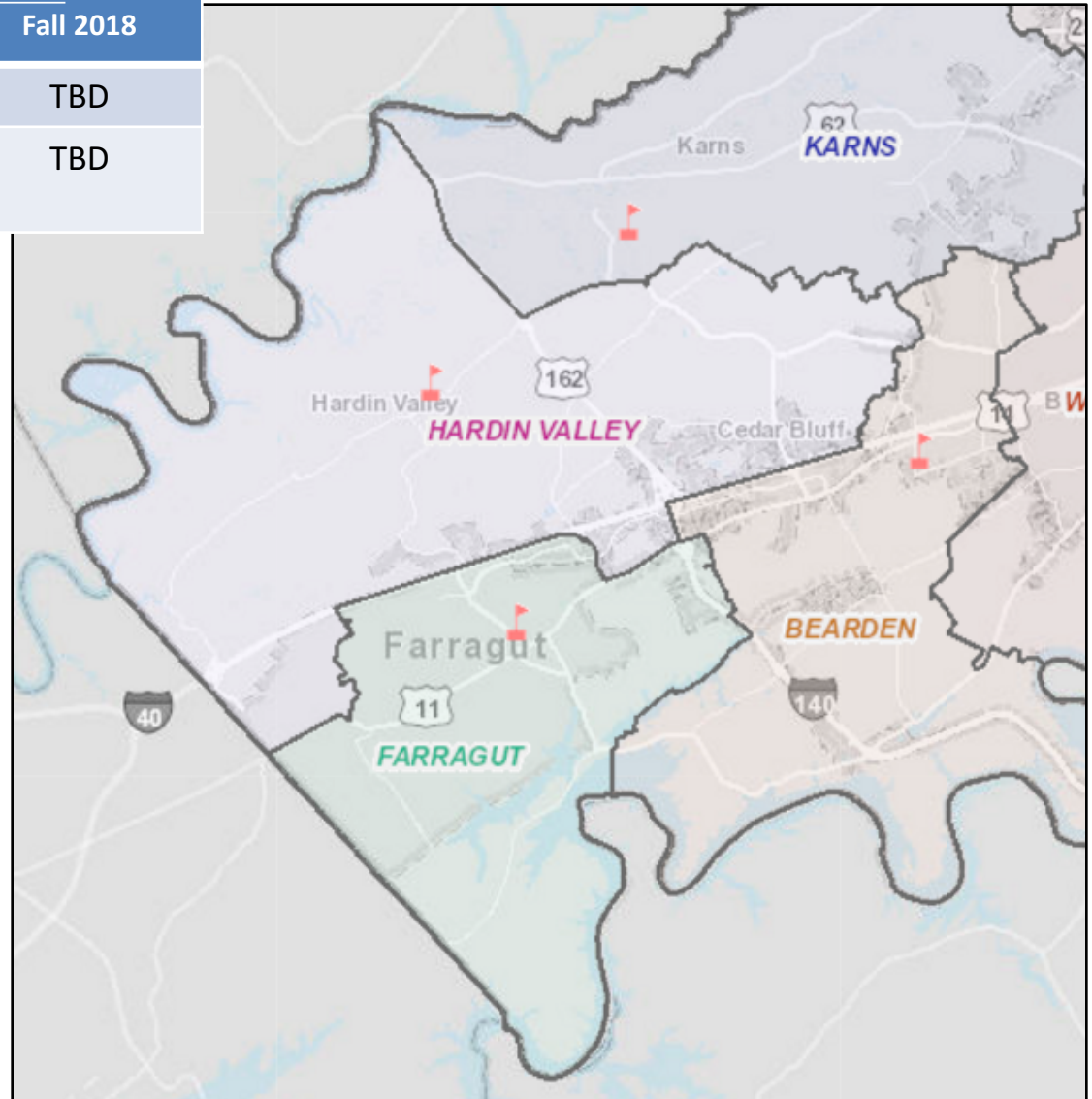
- Requests were made during the recent middle school rezoning discussion to reconsider the school zones for Farragut High School and Hardin Valley Academy
- Some residents requested the southwest portion of the HVA zone be rezoned to Farragut HS
- The area is generally bordered on the west by the Knox County line with Loudon County, on the south by Kingstone Pike, on the east by Everette Road and on the north by I-40/75
- It was zoned to HVA from FHS during the high school rezoning process in 2008
- KCS has maintained a liberal transfer practice for a number of years between HVA and FHS
- Student population has generally split between the two school in recent years

Current HVA/FHS Zones



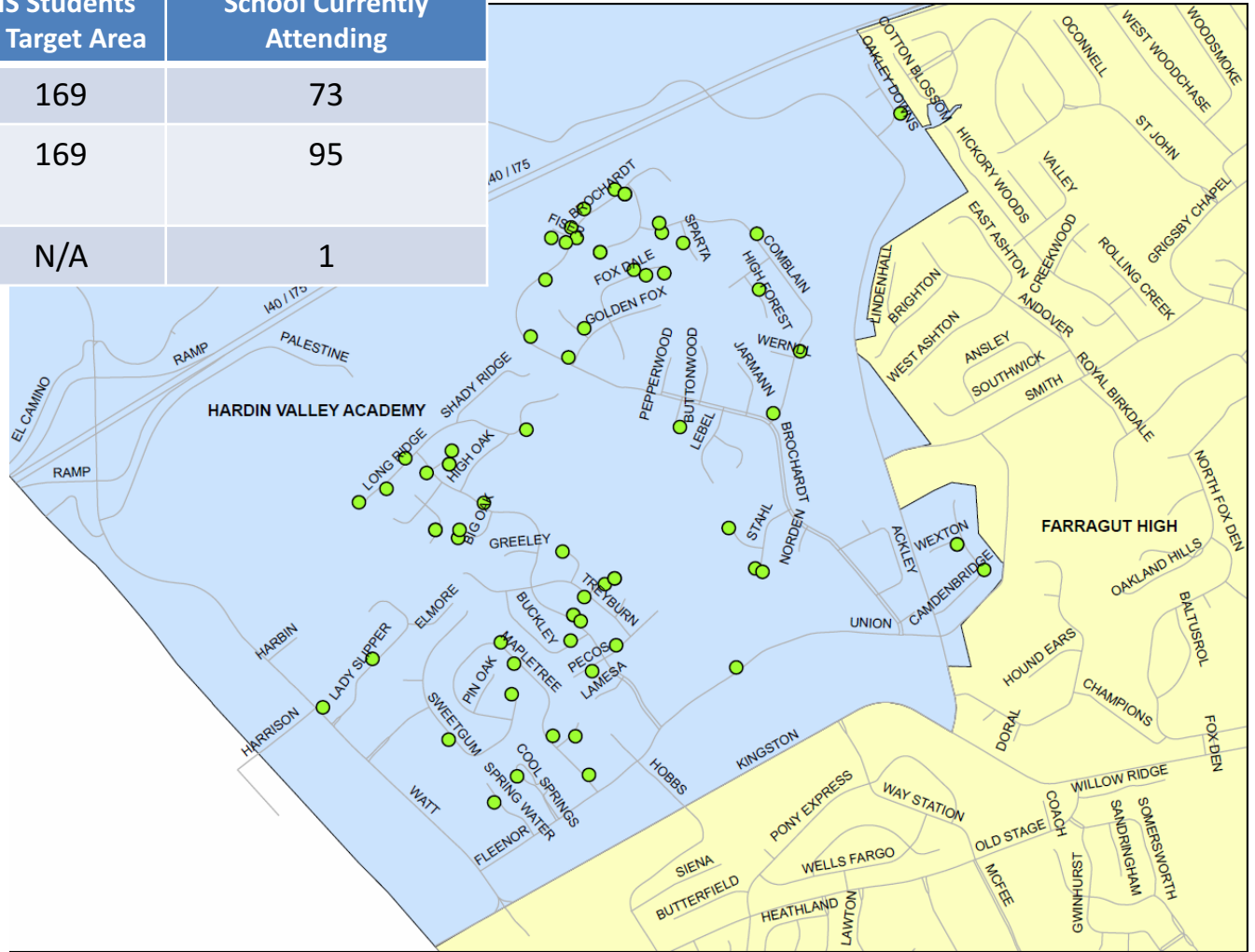
