Elective Focus Area Title (See handout)		Write the title of the Elective Focus Area you have chosen. The titles are written in bold on your handout. Remember, you must complete 3 courses in the same area by the time you graduate.
1. Elective Focus Course (see handout)		You must complete 3 courses in the same elective focus area. IF the courses are numbered, they must be taken in order, so take the next course in the sequence of your chosen elective focus.
2. Elective or World Language (see handout)		World Language (French or Spanish) is required if you haven't completed one yet. Choose an elective if you have met your World Language requirement or plan to waive it.
3. Elective or World Language (see handout)		Select an elective or the 2 nd Level of your chosen World Language.
4. Fine Art or Elective (see handout)		If you do not have a fine art credit yet, please select a fine art class (visual art or music). If you are starting a new Elective Focus, consider taking the 2 nd course of your elective focus or PE if you have not taken it already.

- After school begins in August, no schedule changes will be permitted unless there is an error interfering with a student's graduation plan. So, please be very thoughtful with your selections and mindful of deadlines.
