(1) Class Work...

- **Listening Journals...** Students will listen to musical selections related to the current unit almost every day at the beginning of class. Students will keep a music folder to track their learning and progress throughout the nine-week class. This will include listening Journals, class Notes, assignments, and other written paperwork from class.
- **Canvas Work...** Students submit work on Canvas to be graded based on the current unit of study.

(2) Projects and Tests...

- **Projects...** We will do 2-3 small projects during this 9 week class in which students will showcase their learning by completing and presenting a project.
- **Tests...** We will take a test to determine students' mastery of objectives at the end of any unit in which students do not complete a project.
