- 1. In space #5, you'll select a Wellness track (Lifetime Wellness or ROTC)
- 2. You'll select three (3) Electives for spaces #6 8
- 3. You'll select three (3) Alternate courses

Use the paper worksheet as a your prep for later use when entering your <u>actual requests</u> in ASPEN. Keep the paper worksheet for your records.

"...so, there will be a total of 11 classes...does that mean I'll have 11 classes in my high school schedule?"

No. You will take 8 classes each year. We just ask you to provide us with 3 extra choices to be sure you have a full schedule that reflects your voice.

You'll have 4 classes in the FALL term... ...Then 4 *different* classes in the SPRING term

The exception is if you are in Honors English & AP Human Geography. These 2 classes meet all year long; every other day.

WHAT IS A PREREQUISITE?

Pre•req•ui•site

(e.g., if a student wants to take Adv Art Printmaking in 9th grade,

they must also select Visual Art 1)

NIC Foundations of Supply Chain Mgt:

prerequisite of Intro to Business & Mkt

QUESTIONS ABOUT WORLD LANGUAGE

<u>New this year</u> - World Language is open for CP level students as long as they are on track to get a high "B" or "A" in their 8th grade English course. If interested in selecting a World Language, students are encouraged to select French, German or Latin. Seats in Spanish are <u>very</u> limited.

Q: I'm in Honors Spanish 1 in 8th grade, what do I select?

A: You should select Spanish 2.

Q: I took Exploratory French in 7th & 8th grade, can I take French?

A: Yes, but you will start in French 1. The Exploratory level world language courses are not the high school level world languages.
