Ready Graduate Indicators

The **Ready Graduate indicator** is an accountability metric outlined in Tennessee's Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) plan. The Ready Graduate indicator measures the percentage of students who earn a diploma from a Tennessee high school and meet success milestones that increase their probability of seamlessly enrolling in postsecondary education and securing high-quality employment. Students are considered a "Ready Graduate" by meeting one of the milestones below:

- ✓ ACT/SAT: earn a composite score of 21 or higher on the **ACT** or a 1060 or higher on the **SAT**
- ✓ 4 EPSOs: complete four early postsecondary opportunities (EPSOs)
- ✓ 2 EPSO + earn an **industry certification**: complete two EPSOs + earn an **industry certification**
- ✓ 2 EPSOs + earn an **ASVAB AFQT** score of **31** → Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB) Armed Forces Qualifying Test (AFQT)

Bearden High School currently partners with Pellissippi State, LMU, ETSU and Tusculum. Career and technical education courses are also available through TCAT. Students who earn four (4) dual enrollment classes are considered a ready graduate.

- The State of Tennessee awards a grant for up to four DE classes. Additional courses may require payment from the student.
- Students must complete a BHS dual enrollment application by March 4th for the 2022-2023 school year at this link: <https://forms.gle/Ggh2KaRzFFJCKx1z7>
- Seniors can take up to two DE classes each semester.
- Juniors can take one DE class each semester.
- Students must take all DE semester courses from the same college partner.

State Dual Credit Classes (SDC) → pass an exam, earn college credit at TN State Universities. Could qualify for graduation with state distinction.
