2020 REOPENING PLAN



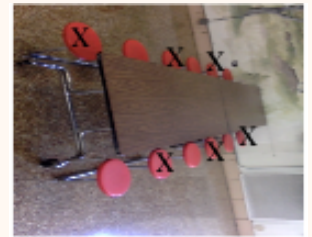
ARRIVAL



- Students will be required to wear masks on the bus.
- Students will be required to wear masks when entering the building and throughout the school day.
- Temperature checks will be done daily upon arrival to school.
- Any student with a temperature of 100.4 or greater will be sent home.
- Students with a fever and Covid-19 symptoms must remain home for 72 hours (3 days) and be cleared by a physician to return to school.
- No families will be allowed to escort their child into the building.

MORNING TIME

- Students arriving to school before 7:30 will go to cafeteria or gymnasium.
- Students going to breakfast will be social distancing in the line, wearing masks and sitting a seat apart in the cafeteria. Only 6 students will be allowed at a table. Students will take off masks to eat, but will put masks back on when leaving cafeteria.
- Students not eating breakfast will go to the gymnasium and will sit on a designated spot with masks on their face.
- Tables will be cleaned thoroughly after breakfast.
- Students will be dismissed from the gymnasium by their teacher.
- To allow for more traffic in the morning, tardy bell will ring at 7:50.



CLASSROOMS & BATHROOMS



- Students and Staff will wear masks in the classroom and all common areas.
- Students will have assigned seats and assigned materials/supplies in the classroom.
- Students will remain with their teacher throughout the day, unless they are pulled for Special Education, Speech or Tier II and III interventions.
- Special Area teachers will rotate to the classroom except PE and Library. All special area teachers will see the same classes for a week for less exposure.
- Students will take a bathroom break throughout the day when needed. Only one student at a time per classroom will be allowed to go.
- Bathrooms will be cleaned throughout the day.



LUNCHTIME



- Students will wear masks into the cafeteria and will be social distancing while standing in the food service line.
- Only one grade level at a time will be eating in the cafeteria. K-10:15-11:00, 1st-11:15-12:00, 2nd-12:15-1:00, PreK-12:20-12:50
- Students will sit 4-6 at a table depending on how many students are in the classroom with seat(s) in between them.
- Students will remove masks to eat their lunch.
- Students will not be allowed to get out of their seat during lunchtime **unless** it's an emergency to go to bathroom.
- No Parent/Visitor will be allowed to eat lunch with a student.
- Students will put masks back on after eating and be dismissed one class at a time.
- Tables will be cleaned **by adults** after each grade level eats.

PLAYGROUND

- The playground will be open to students during the school day.
- There will only be one grade level at a time on the playground spread out in quadrants.
- Masks do not have to be worn outdoors at recess as long as social distancing can be maintained.



DISMISSAL



- First load of bus riders will be dismissed at 2:40 to safely load the buses while maintaining social distancing. Students will wear masks.
- Car riders will be dismissed to their assigned areas. Students will wear masks.

SICKNESS

- If a child becomes sick during the day, that child will be isolated in a room with an adult.
- Parents will be notified and will need to pick up child immediately.
- If child has Covid-19 symptoms, then child will need to stay home for 72 hours (3 days) and be cleared by a physician to return to school.
- A child will have to be fever free for 24 hours without medicine before returning to school.
- A child who is sick with vomiting has to be 24 hours free of vomiting before returning to school.



VISITORS & VOLUNTEERS



- Visitors will not be permitted in the building unless for a previously scheduled meeting that cannot happen virtually. Visitors will need to wear masks.
- All visitors will be asked screening questions and have their temperature taken. If a visitor has a temperature of 100.4 or greater, the meeting will be rescheduled.
- Visitors must have ID when coming to the school for meetings or to sign out a student. No exceptions.
- At this time, we are restricting volunteers in the building.
