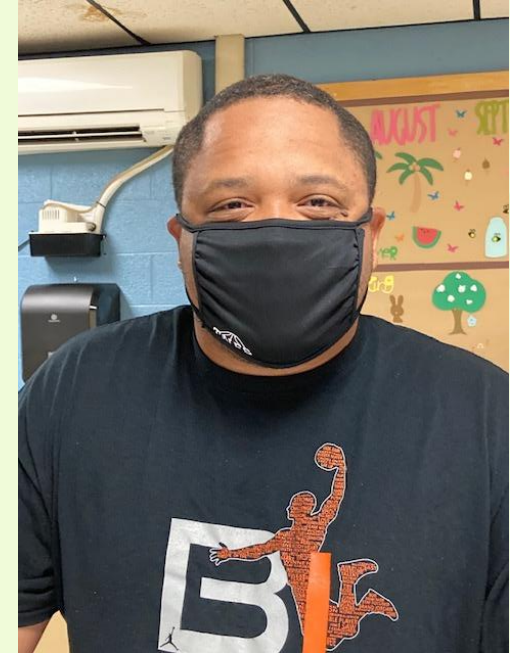
## Grade Level Assistant: Mary Blakely
