Dear Parent/Guardian,

Beat the school rush for your child's upcoming 7th grade immunizations!

All students' entering 7th grade are required to have a Tdap booster and varicella (chicken pox) vaccine on the first day of class, August 10, 2020. Students must provide a Tennessee Immunization Certificate with the immunizations documented. If this requirement is not met, your child will not be able to attend school.

The Knox County Health Department is available to provide the vaccines and will bill your insurance accordingly. If you choose to have your child's vaccine administered by your healthcare provider, please remember verification is required on the first day of school. Scheduled appointments for immunizations after school begins will not serve as substitute for school entry.
