In order to provide an orderly

and meaningful commencement ceremony for the Class of 2019, Karns High School developed procedures to which each potential graduate must adhere. The 2019 procedures are as follows:

1. All candidates for a diploma

or certificate must attend the commencement practice session.

Students should report to

Thompson Boling Arena no later than 9:45 a.m. on Friday, May 17, 2019.

- **Students should bring their gowns with them to rehearsal for the group picture.
- 2. Commencement is at 4:30 p.m.

on Saturday, May 18, 2019. On the afternoon of commencement, all students must report to the tunnels of Thompson Boling Arena and be in line no later than 3:30 p.m.

3. Dress Code: Appropriate dress

is required on the morning of commencement. If you wear a dress, the hem should not fall below the hem of the gown, and the collar should not go above the collar line of the gown. All other participants must wear solid-color dress pants and a dress shirt. Men should wear a necktie. All participants must wear dress shoes. Flip-flops are not appropriate. If you need assistance with clothing, please see Counseling Office or Mrs. Stover.

- 4. All students are expected to
- conduct themselves in the proper manner at all ceremonies and activities. Any unnecessary celebratory actions by any student will result in his or her removal from the ceremony and the holding of his or her diploma.
- 5. Seniors must pay any required

fees and turn in all books and uniforms by Wednesday, May 8, 2019, at 3:00 p.m. All fees, excluding the graduation fee, must be paid in the library. Students will be notified on Monday, May 13, 2019, of any outstanding obligations. Students who owe money, books or uniforms after 2:00 p.m. on May 13, 2019, will have their diploma pulled. Pulled diplomas can be picked up at Karns High School on May 20, 2019, after all obligations have been cleared.

6. All Early Graduates must complete an Early

Graduate Withdrawal Form.

7. The \$25.00 graduation fee

covers the expenses of diplomas, programs, decorations, security and other expenses incurred for this ceremony. This fee is set by Knox County.
