What Do I Need?

In order to complete the process on deployment day and for some of the forms below, the student's student ID will be necessary. This is the ID used for logging into KCS applications and computers in previous grades.

- Complete the agreement of completion of Virtual Learning Orientation
- A device agreement must be completed (**REQUIRED**): Registration Forms
- You may sign up for device insurance (Optional): Insurance Forms
- Everyone will have temperature checked and must wear a mask for duration of the deployment.

How Will It Work?

- Please park in the parking lots at the front of the school.
- Please walk up the main concrete entrance and you will be directed towards the cafeteria.
 - We are asking that only **one** parent/guardian accompany a child for deployment.
 This will help us maintain social distancing and limit the number of people in the school building.
- Once deployment is complete, participants will exit a separate cafeteria door away from others.
