


AIMSweb WINTER BENCHMARKS

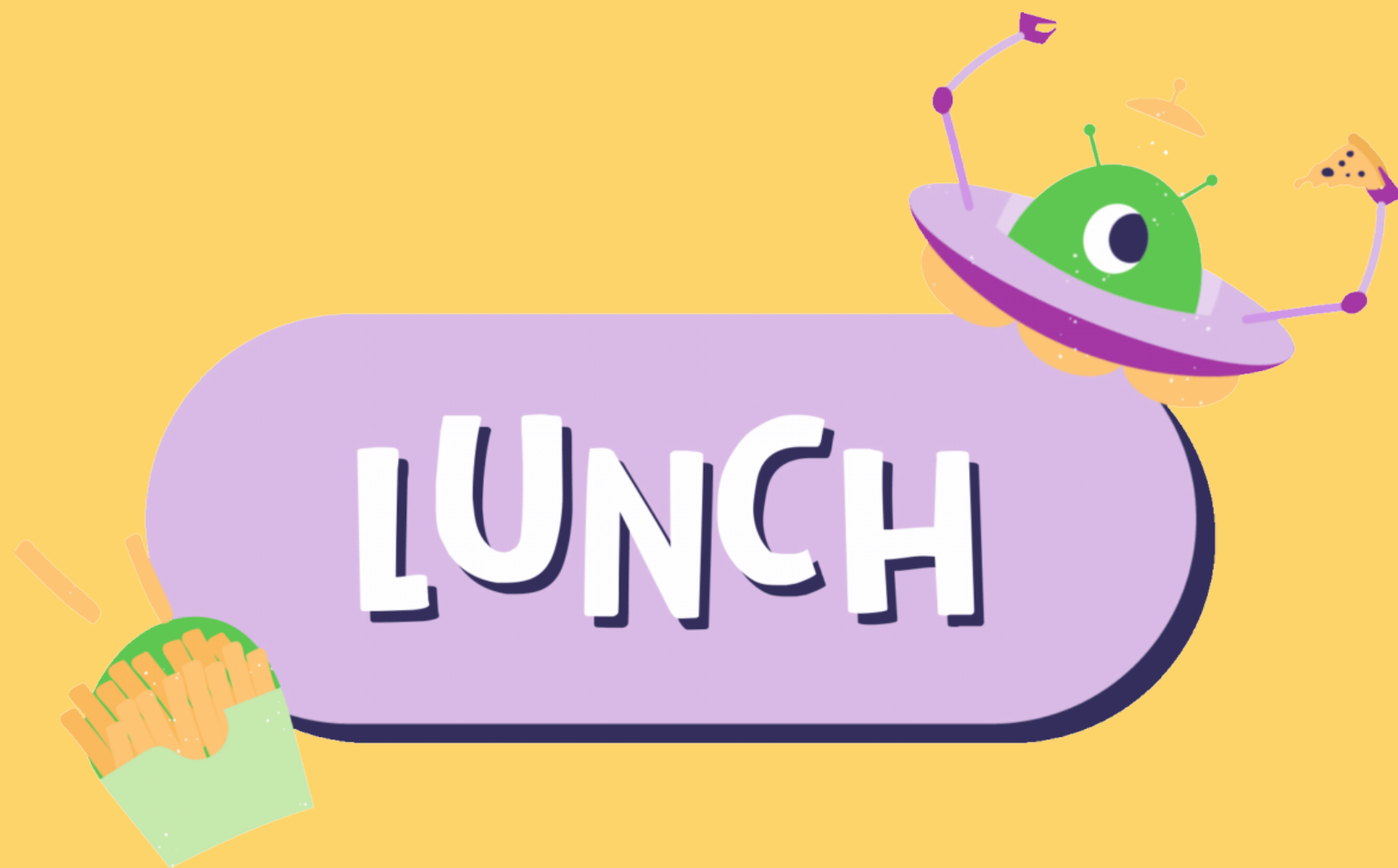
The Spirit Store will be **CLOSED** this week. It will re-open the week of January 23.
