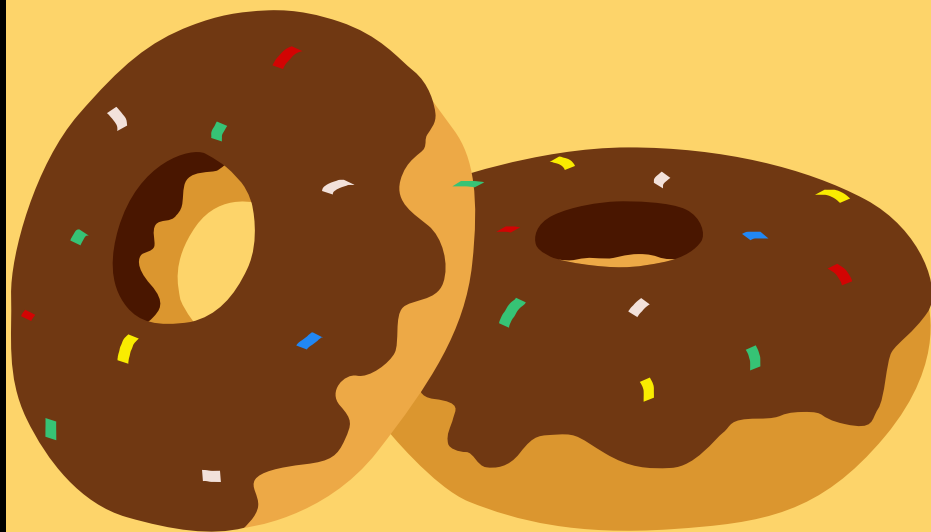

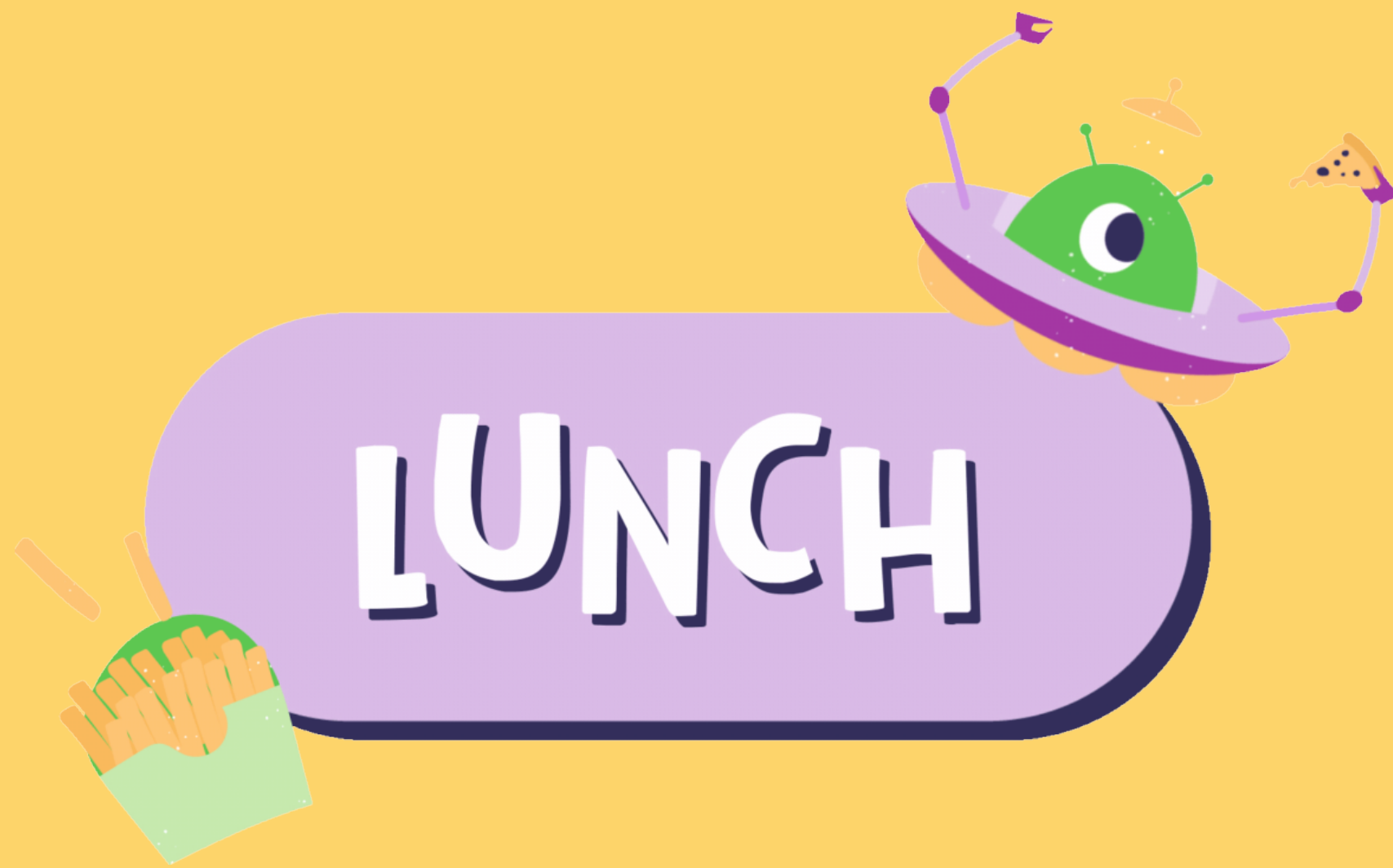


LOANER CHROMEBOOKS
