Proceeds go to the 8th grade Boston trip and the Beta Club National Convention.

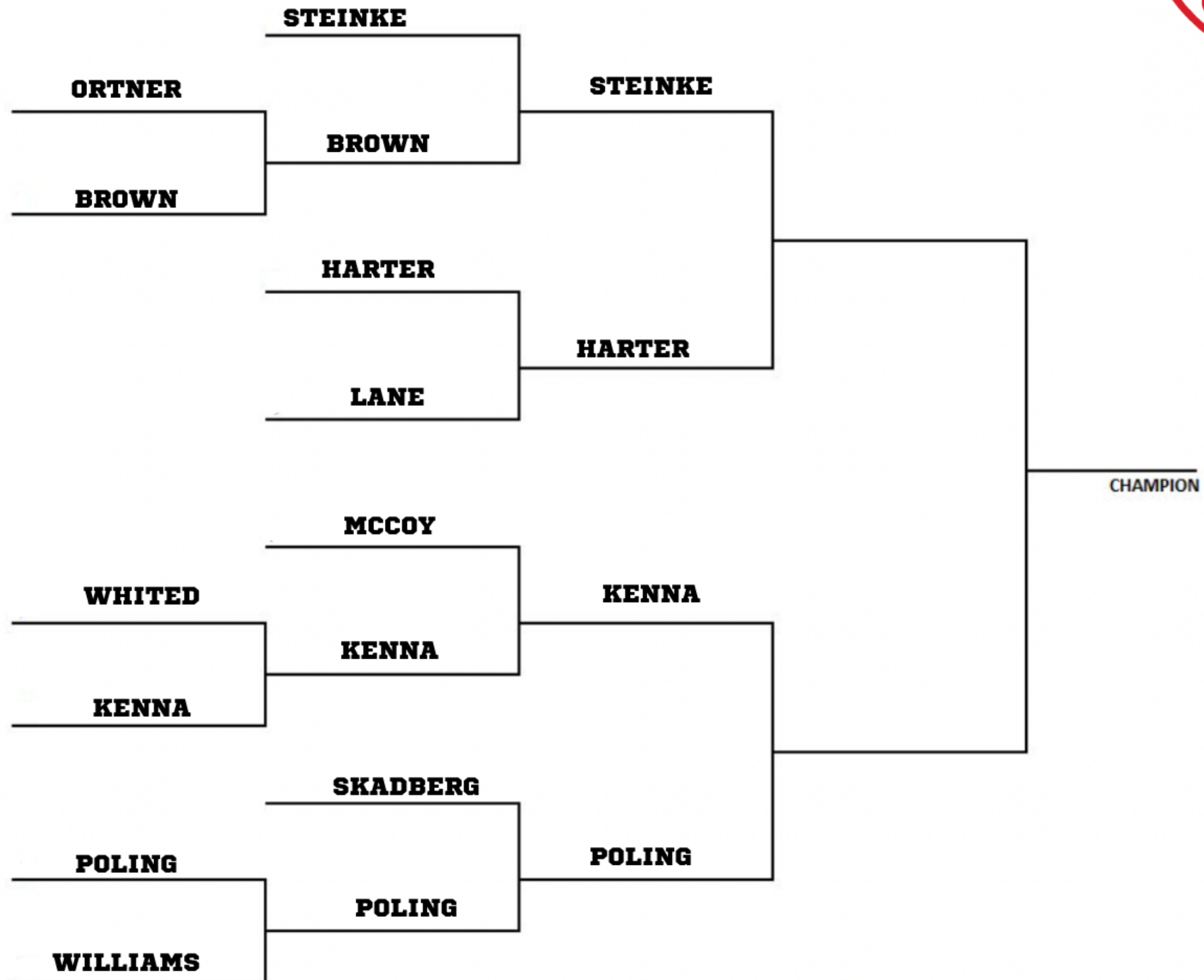
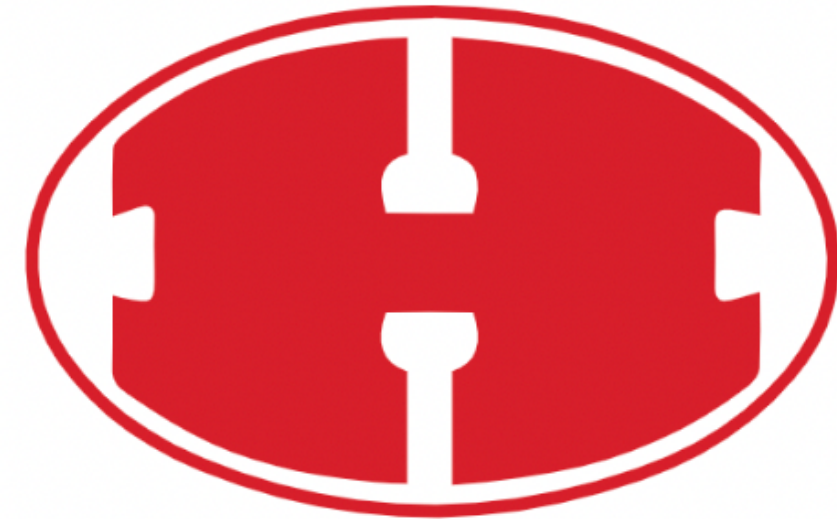
