


PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE


6TH GRADE FIELD TRIP

HOUSE POINTS - CURRENT STANDINGS






HR/Advisory Teachers--Please complete your Chromebook verifications by the end of this week. Video and PDF directions were emailed out this morning.
