Knox County Middle School Dress Code

Knox County Policy for Middle School Cell Phone Use

Policy J-240: Use by Students in Grades 6-8

- Students may possess PCDs while on school property
- The devices may be used before and after school
- Remain in off mode from 8:30 AM 3:30 PM
- Permission to use may be granted by a teacher or principal for a specific academic purpose or other time the principal deems appropriate
- Includes watches that allow texting

Locker and Backpack Tips

- Each student will have his/her own locker ©
- Combination must be provided to the homeroom teacher
- Lockers are subject to search at any time
- If possible, consider using a laptop carrier to enhance the safety of the device


WVMS PTSA
