

Bearden High Important AP Exam Information

Hello AP Students and Parents,

***If you/your student is not taking an AP Exam this year, you can disregard this email!**

The start of AP Exams is approaching; thus, I wanted to communicate some important information regarding test-day procedures. This year, all AP Exams will be in-person, paper/pencil exams. There is no virtual at-home testing.

EXAM SCHEDULE & LOCATIONS:

The **AP Human Geography exam will take place at Bearden High**. The majority of the remaining exams will be off campus. Families are strongly encouraged to practice driving to and from the off-campus locations to familiarize themselves with getting to and from the test site and to reduce test-day distractions.

Most, but not all, off-campus exams will be at [Fellowship Church—8000 Middlebrook Pike, 37909 \(2.5 miles from BHS\)](#).

One exam (AP Literature) will be at [South College—400 Goody's Lane, 37922 \(5.8 miles from BHS\)](#).

Please make sure you look carefully at the test locations for each exam!

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- Students **MUST arrive 15 minutes before** the start of their exam (7:45 a.m. for 8:00 exams and 11:45 a.m. for 12:00 exams) to check-in. Late arrivals may not be admitted to the exam.
- Morning exams should end around 12:00 pm. Afternoon exams should end around 4:00 p.m.
- **PLEASE BRING:** Pencils, black/blue pens, a calculator (if necessary), a sweatshirt or other layer (it can get cold)
- **DO NOT BRING:** Cell phone, smartwatch, or any other wearable technology—leave these at home or in your car.
- Students who miss their exam will be charged an unused exam fee of \$40 per College Board policy.
- *Students in Fall or Spring sections of English Literature, English Language, US Govt, US History, European History and Environmental Science are directed to check the blue AP test lists near the Counseling Office (by the vending machine) to be certain they have an AP test ordered. AP Exam rosters of subjects which have FY or Spring only sections are posted in those teachers' rooms (AP Human Geography, Seminar, Biology, Physics, Chemistry, AB & BC Calc, Statistics)*
- **Attendance for AP Students:**
- Students taking **off-campus morning test:**
 - are excused from 1st, 2nd, and 3rd blocks
 - are expected to be in 4th block*
 - Students who return for 4th block are expected to check-in with the East Mall Office upon arrival at Bearden
- Students taking **an off-campus afternoon test:**
 - are excused from 2nd, 3rd, and 4th blocks
 - are expected to be in 1st block*
 - Bearden maintains rosters of all students who take AP Exams and students have a Medical Release/Field Trip form on file for off-campus AP testing, students do not need to bring a signed note from home indicating that they are leaving at 11:00 or 11:15 to take an off-campus afternoon AP exam
- *Students may use a parent note to excuse a 1st or 4th block class absence due to AP testing
