## **Summer Driver Education 2022**

Registration and payment will be online only (no cash or check will be accepted). See links and additional information related to registration below. NOTE links and/or QR codes go LIVE on 4/19/22 at 12:01am (just after midnight of 4/18/22).

The Summer Driver Education course is available to students of the Knox County Schools on a first come first served basis. Class size is limited to 63 students at Hardin Valley Academy and 45 at Central High School for 108 students total. Registration will close when all driving slots are filled. The Summer Driver Education course will be PASS/FAIL only. Students must be at least 15 years old by May 31st.

**COST:** \$200.00

LOCATION: Central High School or Hardin Valley Academy

Classroom: Three days of classroom instruction are required May31st– June 2nd (Tu – Th), 8:00 am – 12:00 pm. **Attendance is mandatory for ALL students!** 

Driving: Range and road driving will be scheduled over the course of the following 3 weeks. Students will be registered for one Driving Block (6 days) and assigned a two-hour time slot for the remainder of the course. Students will only participate in one six-day block. Once the student completes the 6 days on the range/road, they have completed the course.

Driving Blocks (students will only participate in one of the three below): These driving dates will be determined by parents when registering student and cannot be changed.

- June 3, 6, 7, 8, 9 and 10 (capacity: HVA 21, Central 15)
- June 13, 14, 15, 16, 17 and 20 (capacity: HVA 21, Central 15)
- June 21, 22, 23, 24, 27 and 28 (capacity: HVA 21, Central 15)

Time Slots (two-hours each day during the assigned driving block): These times will be assigned by instructors to each student before driving. The time slots will be assigned during the required classroom days (5/31/22 - 6/2/22). Times will be between 8:00am - 2:00pm.
