



BEARDEN STUDENT PARKING INFORMATION

2021-2022



Who is eligible for a parking tag?

- Parking tags will be made available to seniors and then juniors based on a lottery system.
- To be eligible student must provide a copy of their valid driver's license and current vehicle insurance.
- Freshmen and sophomore students will not be eligible for a parking tag.

How does a student enter the lottery to become eligible for a parking tag?

- Information that will include a link to an application will be sent to all senior contacts via Aspen on July 14. The link for the form will also be shared via the senior class canvas page.
- Seniors MUST complete the application CORRECTLY by **July 21**. A link for the application will be shared with Juniors on July 26 with Aspen contacts and on the class canvas page.

What is the cost for a parking tag and how is it paid?

- Parking tags cost \$45.
- All parking tags must be paid for online through the [School Cash Online](#) system. **Cash and checks will not be accepted.**
- Students who are selected through the lottery will have a link activated in their School Cash Online account to pay for the parking tag. **Seniors must pay for the parking tag in full by July 24.**

Failure to meet any deadlines will result in a student forfeiting his/her opportunity drive for the 21-22 school year.

When can a student pick up his/her parking tag?

- If a student is selected through the lottery and is paid in full, they will be informed via parent contact emails in Aspen that they will be awarded a parking tag for the 21-22 school year.
- Students may pick up their parking tags either August 6 from 8:30-10:30 or during their lunch on August 10. The student assigned the parking tag or the student's guardian must be present in order to be assigned the parking tag.
- Students may pick up their parking tags Aug 11-13 with Ms. Henry from 8:00-8:20.
- Any student that has not picked up their parking tag by the end of the day on August 13 will forfeit their tag.

What are the policies and expectations for student drivers once assigned a parking tag?

- Driving to school is a privilege. Students must follow all rules and policies created by the district and Bearden High School for student drivers. Failure to follow these rules and policies will result in consequences including but not limited to having your parking tag revoked or your car towed.
