FAFSA

The Free Application for Federal Student Aid is a form completed by current and prospective college students in the United States to determine their eligibility for student financial aid. Changes have been made with the FAFSA and will open December 1, 2024. Information will be sent out as soon as more details are shared. If student planning on using TN Promise or Hope scholarships, FAFSA must be complete, regardless of parent/guardian financial aid status. Both students and guardians can create FSA ID's

FAFSA Family Help Night will be scheduled in the winter to help students and families complete the FAFSA if need support.
