

NICOLE KALISTER SCHOLARSHIP

The Nicole Kalister Scholarship is established in memory of former Farragut student, Nicole Kalister. The scholarship is endowed by Jacquelyn Kalister and Family, who shared a many memories and vacations to various amusement parks. While previous scholarships awarded by the Family honored Nicole's future, this one intends to honor the legacy of vibrancy the Kalisters embraced. The scholarship will be administered by the Farragut High School Education Foundation in accordance with the following criteria:

The scholarship will be awarded to a Farragut High School graduate who intends to pursue a career in the amusement park industry. The recipient of the Kalister Scholarship will receive one payment of \$5,000 to be applied towards their education. It will be the responsibility of the scholarship recipient to provide to the Education Foundation verification that the recipient is enrolling or current enrolled in the proper degree. The Foundation will remit any scholarship funds directly to the recipient.

To be considered for the scholarship, the Farragut High School senior must:

1. Complete the application
2. Submit a resume
3. Submit an essay of not more than 250 words on why they should receive the scholarship.

The scholarship recipient will be chosen by Jacquelyn Kalister and Family. It will be within the discretion of Jacquelyn Kalister and Family as to whether the scholarship will be awarded in a particular year.

Deadline to submit your application for the scholarship – October 1st. Any applications received after October 1st will not be considered.
