



En-lightening News with Nurse Amanda



Following these simple tips can help avoid common warm weather illnesses and injuries so your family can enjoy a safe and fun summer!

Sunburn

Wear a hat, seek shade under an umbrella or tree, and apply sunscreen regularly.

Dehydration

Drink plenty of water. Avoid sugary drinks (sodas and sports drinks) and caffeine.

Burns

Use caution around open flames like campfires and BBQs.

Injuries

Always wear a helmet when riding a bike. Young children should stick to riding on sidewalks or in the driveway.

Drowning

Supervise children closely at the swimming pool. Use appropriate floatation devices as needed.

If your child has any medical issues, please let his or her new teacher know. If your child requires medication at school or has special dietary needs, a new doctor's order is required each year. These forms can be picked up at any Knox County School office. Pick up your forms early and be prepared for next year!
