Zoom Meeting Availability: Students will have access to their teachers for signups. Teachers can also be reached for subject-specific assistance during regular office hours. Final Exams:

Seniors - Seniors wishing to graduate with their Gibbs High School class on June 12th must complete their course by Monday, June 8th.

Underclassmen - The “ideal” completion time is Friday, June 26th. Summer school teachers will hold regular office hours for student assistance during this time. Students who can not complete the course by this time will be able to continue working without teacher assistance during office hours and must be ready to take their final exam by Tuesday, July 21st thru Thursday, July 23rd.

Course Completion Goals: Students need to reference the provided completion calendar and strive to maintain a C average or higher especially when taking a recovery credit course. Teachers will be monitoring progress and averages on a daily basis and will contact parent(s) when there is a concern. Students taking more than one course will require accelerated progress. A student taking 2 courses is expected to have DOUBLE the progress for timely completion of their first course. Students must work on 1 course at a time (MATH COURSE ALWAYS FIRST). Switching back and forth between courses is highly discouraged. Teachers will

not combine progress percentages in 2 or more classes in order to determine adequate progress.

Progress Monitoring Dates: Parents will be contacted on the following dates if a student fails to maintain adequate progress (see calendar for percentages) or their average falls below a C. These dates will be marked on the calendar as well.

Grade Computation: SOME courses will have a TEACHER-PROCTORED end of course test (EOC) that will count 15% of the final grade. These tests must be taken at school or during a zoom meeting in order to be supervised.

Initial credit: (Student has NEVER taken the course before and is taking it for NEW credit)

Course with NO state exam: 100% Edgenuity average

Course with state exam: 85% Edgenuity average + 15% Edgenuity EOC grade

Recovery credit: (Student took the course before and made a failing grade 50% or higher)

Course with NO state exam: 25% original average + 15% Edgenuity EOC grade + 60% Edgenuity average

Course with State Test: 25% original average + 15% (Edgenuity or State) EOC + 60% Edgenuity average

If the student has already taken the state test and scored 65% or higher, we will use that score.

If student has already taken the state test and scored LESS than 65%, the student will repeat the EOC on Edgenuity.

Athletes: Edgenuity is approved by NCAA Clearinghouse.
