Art students: Drive around to the back parking lot and Mr. Gentry will meet you at the OUTSIDE door.

**Band:** Report to the OUTSIDE door to the band room at the front of the building. The directors will meet you there.

**<u>Chromebooks</u>**: Return Chromebook device and charging cable to Mr. Ellis/Newberry in the front lobby.

**DECA:** Return notebooks to the DECA table in the Commons.

Driver's Ed students: Certificates will be available from Coaches Taylor and Henson in the Commons.

**<u>ROTC</u>**: Report to Byington Solway location and your instructors will meet you there.

**Sports uniforms:** Coaches for teams needing to return items will have tables in the Commons.

**YEARBOOK PICK UP:** Students who have ordered and paid for a yearbook will report to room #111 (first room on the first hall to the left upon entering building) to get their books. Ms. Baker will be at the door to the room and will issue the book. Students will sign indicating receipt.
