But I don't eat school lunch.

We urge families to complete the Free/Reduced Lunch application even if their child does not eat school lunch.

If enough of our families qualify, Karns High School can

- Receive schoolwide funding assistance for ALL students because qualifying students remain <u>ANONYMOUS</u>.
- Receive funding proportional to the real needs of our students. Funds can be spent on staffing, supplies, curriculum needs, and technology.
- Have greater flexibility and freedom to address student needs as they arise.
- Have funds to support parent and community engagement.
