<u>FAFSA</u>

The Free Application for Federal Student Aid is a form completed by current and prospective college students in the United States to determine their eligibility for student financial aid. The FAFSA does not open until October of students' senior year. If student planning on using TN Promise or Hope scholarships, FAFSA must be complete, regardless of financial aid status.
