BETS PROGRAM

JUNE 15-24

Introduces underrepresented high school juniors, first-generation college students, or students who receive free or reduced-cost lunch to all aspects of the business world.

AIM ACADEMY

JULY 10-15

Familiarizes underrepresented high school sophomores with the field of accounting & information management.

WEB INSTITUTE

JULY 10-15

Empowers female high school sophomores to seek careers in the fields of business and technology.



All interested students must be high school juniors or sophomores with at least a 3.0 GPA, show exceptional leadership potential, and have an interest in studying business. Students are encouraged to seek careers in the subject matter area.

What you need to know.

In what activities will students be involved?

Students attend classes, develop an executive presentation, visit a local company, and shadow professionals, interact with business students from UT, and hear presentations from various professionals on campus (Admissions, OneStop, Office of Undergraduate Programs).

Who will teach the classes?

Faculty members from Haslam and area-wide business and community leaders lead the classes.

Who may apply?

Underrepresented high school rising seniors (class of 2023) and rising juniors (class of 2024), first-generation college students, and students eligible for free or reduced lunch. Applicants must have at least a 3.0 GPA, show exceptional leadership potential, and have an interest in studying business.

What is the cost?

There is no cost to attend. However, a \$20 seat reservation fee is required once selected for a program. All program fees are covered for all selected students. This includes the cost of tuition, room and board, meals, books, and supplies.

Where will students reside?

Students are required to live in the residence hall at UT to help them become familiar with the on-campus living environment.

What are the requirements to apply?

Students must have an interest in business but are not required to have completed business courses. Students must complete an application, provide a copy of a high school transcript, submit a letter of recommendation, and show involvement in school- and/or community-affiliated activities.

Who will supervise the students?

Students are supervised by university faculty, staff, administrators, and program counselors.

When is the deadline?

The application must be submitted by **March 31, 2022**. Students will be notified of their acceptance within **three weeks** of the deadline.
