Why One to One?

We all know that a revolution in technology is transforming our world and will shape our children's lives to an extent we can hardly imagine. Education must respond to this rapidly changing reality just as other fields are doing.

Research shows that successful One to One programs integrate technology into already strong instruction. One to One is not intended to replace traditional teaching or to magically raise our children's scores. Rather, it:

- augments the resources and methods available to teachers and students
- enhances best teaching practices
- diminishes the negative impact of economic and social disparities among students, and improves learning for all

One to One is the next step in the effective use of technology in the classroom. It reshapes the fundamental dynamics of the classroom, enabling truly personalized instruction.

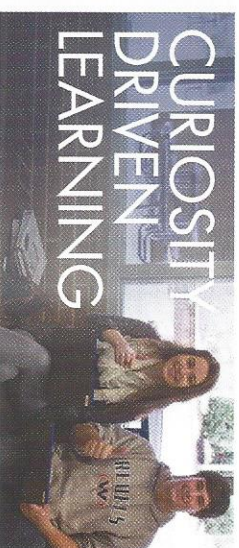
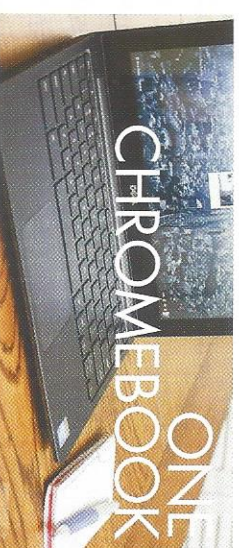
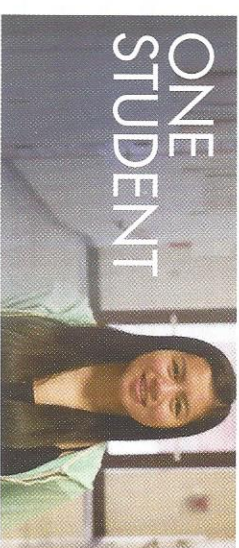
