<u>Amount(s)</u> Available: Up to \$500.00 per application but larger requests will be considered if the award will benefit multiple teachers/staff and/or students. Previous year's awards ranged from \$80.00 to \$550.00.

#### Enrichment Fund Guidelines:

- 1. Teachers and staff must be PTSO members to receive grants (PTSO dues are \$5.00 for faculty staff and membership forms are available in the mailroom).
- 2. Requests related to teaching and classroom support will be given first consideration.
- 3. Please discuss your request with your department chair.
- 4. Creative and new ideas or activities are welcome.
- 5. Requests must include specific cost amounts/estimates or they will not be considered.
- 6. All requests will be reviewed and presented to the PTSO Board for a vote at the meeting following the deadline. Notification of awards will be sent shortly thereafter.

### **\*\***This program does not cover requests for teams, clubs, conferences, or social fees.

**Examples of Previously Funded Requests**: Choral and instrumental sheet music, foreign language magazines and novels, nutrition lab ingredients, theater scripts, art magazines, vocabulary materials, guest lecturers, science specimens, classroom materials for special projects, and classroom sessions with an animator.

All requests must be submitted by Friday, October 1, 2021 at 3:30 p.m. for the 1st semester and by Friday, February 11, 20222 at 3:30 p.m. for the 2nd semester.
