

BRICKEY-MCCLLOUD 2020 REOPENING PLAN

ARRIVAL AND DISMISSAL



- Students will enter in multiple locations of the building.
- Temperature checks will be done daily upon arrival to school.
- Students with a temperature greater than 100.4 will be sent home.
- Students with a fever and COVID-19 symptoms must remain home for 72 hours and be cleared by a physician to return to school.
- Students will wear a mask upon entering the building and report to their classroom.
- No families will be allowed to escort their child into the building.

CLASSROOMS

- Students and staff will wear a mask in the classroom and all common areas. Masks will be worn unless students are able to be 6 feet apart.
- Students will have assigned seats and assigned materials in the classroom.
- For students in 3rd-5th grades, the subject area teacher will rotate into the classrooms. The students will remain in their homeroom class throughout the day.



CAFETERIA

- Students will wear a mask while going through the meal line. Masks are not required while eating or drinking.
- Students will have assigned tables. Students will sit every other seat at that table. Students will eat either in the cafeteria or in their classroom to provide space.



PLAYGROUND

- The playground will be open to students during the day.
- There will only be one grade level at a time on each playground. Masks do not have to be worn outdoors as long as physical distancing can be maintained.



VISITORS

- Most meetings involving parents will be online or as a phone conference until further notice.
- Visitors will not be permitted in the building unless for a previously scheduled meeting that cannot happen virtually.
- All visitors will be asked screening questions and have their temperature taken. If a visitor has a temperature of 100.4 or greater, the meeting will be rescheduled. Visitors must have ID when coming to the school for meetings or to sign out a student. No exceptions.
