Reopening Plan 2020-2021

Masks	 * All students, staff, and visitors with appointments will be required to wear masks upon entering the building, when moving through the hallways, and in common areas. * Masks are required when social distancing is not possible (less than 6 feet apart). * Students may remove their masks when eating. * Teachers may require students to wear masks all day.
Health and Safety	 * All students, staff and approved visitors will have their temperature checked prior to entering the school. * Social distancing will be maintained whenever possible throughout the building. (6 feet apart). * Students and staff will clean their hands multiple times throughout the day. * Frequently touched surfaces will be cleaned multiple times daily. * Visitors to the building will be accepted by appointment only and temperatures will be checked.
Arrival	 * Buses will run as normal. Students will wear masks, sit with siblings, and have assigned seats. * All students not riding buses must enter through the car rider line. * Parents may not walk students into school. * Students will go to the cafeteria for breakfast or wait in the hallways or gym by grade level. * Temperatures will be taken in car rider line. Car rider line wait time may be longer than usual. * Please build in additional time in your morning routine so that your student can get to class on time.
Classroom	 * Social distancing will be maintained whenever possible in classrooms (6 feet apart). * Masks must be worn when social distancing is not possible (6 feet apart). * Materials used by multiple students will be cleaned between each use.
Cafeteria	 * Masks must be worn to and from breakfast and lunch. * Masks must be worn when going through the food line. * Masks may be removed when eating and drinking. * Students will eat in the cafeteria with appropriately distanced seating. * Tables and seats will be cleaned between each use. * Visitors will not be permitted for the first semester.
Hallways	 * Social distancing will be maintained whenever possible (6 feet apart). * Masks must be worn when social distancing is not possible during transitions (arrival, dismissal, restrooms, cafeteria, Special Areas, Recess, etc.). * Students will be required to wash hands when they return to the classroom.
Virtual Option	* With the Virtual Option, students will be using synchronous & asynchronous learning to engage in instruction. Students will be required to be available daily from 8:00 am to 2:30 pm (12 noon for Kindergarten).
