 May 20<sup>th</sup> 4:00 to approximately 5:00 pm (It varies based on the number of students that try out)

The attached permission slip and a copy of the student's physical must be turned in by the start of clinics on May 17. The physical must be dated after April 15, 2021. The permission slips can be dropped off in the office or sent to Carter Middle School attention Jantzen Fielden.

DANCERS MUST BE PRESENT ALL CLINIC DAYS IN ORDER TO TRYOUT THURSDAY MAY 20<sup>TH</sup>.

## Each judge will score dancers on:

- Individual skills: Kick, Turn, Leap, Split, and Toe-Touch
- Dance Routine: Timing, Confidence, and Accuracy
- Clinic Score

For the tryouts, dancers must wear black pants, capris, or shorts and a plain white shirt. Hair must be pulled back.

An administrator will be present for auditions and while the scores are being tabulated. Dancers with the highest scores will be chosen to represent Carter Middle School on the dance team. Dance team members will be posted on the gym door by 6pm. Remind 101 will be used to communicate information, practice, and game details with parents.

Carter Middle School Dance team members will be held to high standards for both behavior and academics. Dancers must maintain a 2.0 GPA and good behavior. Dancers must be at school the day of the game in order to perform.

Each dancer will be financially responsible for necessary dance team purchases. Costs below are approximate and may vary depending on shipping, tax, and variations in styles/color.

• Knox County Insurance Fee: \$60

• Shoes: \$12

• Costumes: \$75

• Bag: \$35

• Camp: \$25

Team shirt: \$35Embroidery: \$30

• Tights: \$25

Fee Total: \$300

\*These totals are estimations; cost could change or adjust as needed. Returning members will be given a lower fee seeing as how they have previously purchased some reusable items.

Practices will be held 1 to 2 times a week. Dates and times will be decided after the team is formed. For practice, dancers must wear appropriate attire and shoes. Hair should be neatly pulled back. Dancers are expected to attend all practices and games unless they are absent from school or have prior approval. If an emergency arises please contact Mrs. Fielden through the remind app. Dancers who miss multiple practices and/or games will be subject to dismissal.

\*Practice and performance plans are subject to change depending on the level of operations in school (red, yellow, green). If students are unable to perform a refund cannot be promised.
