Frequently Asked Questions:

How do I know if my child is scheduled to test?

If your child is currently enrolled in English 1, English 2, Algebra 1, Algebra 2, Geometry, Biology, or U. S. History, then your child has a state test.

Does my child have to come into the building to test?

The tests are paper / pencil tests so the student has to be physically present in the building to test.

What safety precautions are in place for virtual students coming into the building?

Virtual students will test in the auditorium. All proctors and students will be wearing masks during testing and desks are cleaned after each testing session.

Are virtual students allowed to take the bus to school on testing days?

Yes, virtual students are allowed to ride the bus to school but will need to make arrangements for transportation home after testing is complete. If you have questions about transportation, please contact Bevin Gresham at bevin.gresham@knoxschools.org.

How does my child know where to report for testing?

Virtual students should check in outside of the library and then report to the auditorium. In person students will be notified by their teacher where to report for testing.

Are virtual students allowed to leave as soon as they are done testing?

Yes, virtual students must leave the building immediately after the testing session is complete so they can attend their virtual classes for the remainder of the day.

What should my child do if they missed all or part of a test?

There are days built in for make up exams. If a student missed all or part of a test, they should report to the library at 8:30 on the days designated as make up exam days.
