

ELL Supports for Viewing Videos

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If you are listening to a video clip that is difficult to understand the following suggestions could help.

- 1. Turn on closed captions if available.
- 2. Adjust the playback speed to slow down the video. After you have listened at a slow sped, increase the speed and listen again.
- 3. If these options are not available for the video you are watching, watch short clips of the video then pause, listen, and watch again.
- 4. Ask someone in your home to watch the video with you. Stop frequently and tell your friend what you heard and understood.
- 5. If there is a text associated with the video, read the text first and identify difficult words before watching the video.
- 6. After watching video, write a sentence, or create a drawing or chart that represents the information in the video. Ask someone in your home if they agree with your drawing or summary.
