

HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT GRADING CHOICE

In accordance with recent action taken by the Tennessee State Board of Education, students enrolled in high school credit bearing courses will have input into how their final grade is determined.

On Friday April 24 parents/students will be able to view a student's Quarter 3 grade in Aspen, then they will have until Wednesday, April 29 to choose either, option A or option B via an assignment in the Aspen student portal (details below):


- Option A - Student wishes to make his/her Quarter 3 grade his/her final grade for the Spring 2020 semester. This student does not plan to complete additional educational review materials in order to improve his/her final grade.
- Option B - According to recent action taken by the Tennessee State Board of Education, a student's grade cannot drop below the grade he/she had at Quarter 3 (March 12, 2020 for KCS). A student choosing option B intends to complete review educational resources and submit to their teacher digitally between Friday, May 1, 2020 - Monday May 18, 2020 in an attempt to increase their final grade. These efforts can potentially increase a student's Grade Point Average and make them eligible to access additional scholarship dollars, NCAA eligibility, etc.

If you choose option B, you need to email me for further directions on the additional educational resources

To ensure the health and safety of teachers and students, all resources will only be submitted digitally by students to teachers through the digital platforms of Canvas, Aspen or through email. The teacher shall communicate his/her digital platform for student submission to students choosing option B.


