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

# What is Genius Hour?


Sometimes called "Passion Projects" or "20% Projects"

Originated at Google, where employees dedicate 20% of their time to developing their own ideas (such as gmail and Google News)

The idea is catching on in schools as a way to promote student-driven, personalized learning

Encourages students to come up with their own questions, do their own research and form their own conclusions.



First or last day of the month


Show videos of interesting ideas




