Describe the contributions of modern presidents

Monday

- 1. Watch video about presidents (<u>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=B_8yQ2plaAE</u>)
- 2. Ask student if they think all presidents think and do the same thing or if they have different ideas and interests.
- 3. Building on this, discuss with student how they think this plays into their leadership. If they care about something, are they more or less likely to pass a law that supports what they care about?
- 4. Ask your student what they would do if they were president linking to their interests.

Tuesday

- 1. Pick a president from the list: John F. Kennedy, Lydon B. Johnson, Richard M. Nixon, or Gerald R. Ford
- 2. Research the chosen president using the worksheet attached to identify a contribution

Wednesday

- 1. Pick a president from the list: Jimmy Carter, Ronald Reagan, or George Bush
- 2. Research the chosen president using the worksheet attached to identify a contribution

Thursday

- 1. Pick a president from the list: Bill Clinton, George W. Bush, Barack Obama, or Donald J. Trump
- 2. Research the chosen president using the worksheet attached to identify a contribution

Friday

- 1. Compare and contrast the president's contributions by using the worksheet attached.
- 2. For #3, ask your student if the answer given on Monday (question #4) would be a "good contribution" or if they would change what they would like to contribute after learning about president contributions.
