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2020 Chinese I Summer Scholar's Guide User's Guide

The World Language Summer Scholar's Guide bridges the gap between levels. It connects the most critical concepts from the previous level to the next level.

Under normal circumstances, Level I students should have reached a Novice Mid proficiency level. Given the unplanned abrupt end to the Spring 2020 semester, students may have only had the opportunity to reach Novice Low proficiency. Normally, Level 2 students would begin the semester at Novice Mid reaching for Novice High. This Summer Scholar's Guide will help preserve learning and provide an opportunity for students to still reach an Novice Mid proficiency level by the end of Level I.

Suggested pacing is provided in the chart below. Following this pace will help you retain prior learning and progress more quickly to the next proficiency level once we return to school.
