
HOW WILL I ACCESS THE TEAMS APP?


On a Chromebook: Click on the Student Bookmarks on the Bookmarks Bar in Chrome

Click on MyApplications Portal


Go to All Apps

HOW DO I SIGN INTO TEAMS?

Enter student ID and Student Password:

Example - **Username:** s1234567@student.knoxschools.org

Example - **Password:** JS4567kcs

HOW WILL I ACCESS A TEAMS MEETING?

Through a Canvas Course, email, or directly in the Teams App.

Click on the Join Microsoft Teams Meeting link.

You may be prompted to choose the web-based version or the app. Choose to join the app version for full meeting capabilities.



The app version can be loaded on a Chromebook.


WHO WILL BE IN THE MEETING?

You will be able to see the people in the meeting. Be sure to use the Teams App for optimal meeting experience.


As each person talks, the speaker should appear on your screen.

MUTE YOUR MICROPHONE WHEN YOU ARE NOT SPEAKING







CHECK YOUR VIDEO ANGLE, WE WANT TO SEE YOUR FACE, NOT YOUR CHEEK OR UP YOUR NOSE



MAKE SURE YOUR MIC IS NOT MUFFLED, AND THAT YOU SPEAK CONFIDENTLY & CLEARLY





BE CONSIDERATE WITH YOUR WORDS



CHECK YOUR LIGHTING, NO LIGHT BEHIND YOU (LIKE A WINDOW)

What are Teams Meeting Expectations?

- KCS approved dress
- Listen to the educator or individual speaking
- Be conscious of background noise
- Mute your microphone when you're not speaking
- Use chat feature for questions and comments
- Choose a well-lit room and avoid sitting with a window behind you
- Stay engaged throughout the lesson or activity
- Raise your virtual hand on the toolbar to ask a question



WHAT HAPPENS IF I HAVE TECHNICAL DIFFICULTIES DURING A MEETING?

What happens if I am disconnected from the meeting? Rejoin the meeting by clicking on the original link you were sent.

What happens if I am signed in as a guest in a meeting? Hang up and, sign into your KCS account, and rejoin the meeting.

What do I do if I cannot hear the person speaking? Most likely, the person has his/her microphone muted. You may wish to make a comment in the chat or you may unmute your microphone and let the speaker know. You may need to adjust the volume on your computer or phone.
