

AP Literature Stand Alone & AP Literature Combined Summer Reading

Students should read the following texts prior to the first day of AP Literature class. Students are NOT required to complete an additional assignment regarding these texts. However, students may expect assessments in their individual classes at the start of the semester. Students are strongly encouraged to read the texts twice for an appropriate depth of understanding. Students should also annotate the texts. If you own the books, then you should write in them. (Please see the back of this page for examples of annotation strategies.) If you do not own “your” book, then you may annotate on post-it notes. Students will be tested over these works early in the semester in which they are enrolled.
