## **Superintendent Bob Thomas**

- Superintendent Thomas welcomed everyone to the meeting and thanked them for being willing to serve on the committee.
- Superintendent Thomas introduced himself and also talked about the many roles he has had over the years working for Knox County Schools. He talked briefly about his family and also stated that he enjoys being in the position of Superintendent.
- Superintendent Thomas shared that he appreciated all of the important work that our staff do every day.
- Mr. Thomas shared that Teacher Advisory Committee meetings are public noticed and Board members may attend.
- He shared with the committee members that he wanted them to be open, honest and tell him the truth about how they feel.
- Mr. Thomas shared that KCS has been working with KCEA to lower the cost of insurance premiums.
- Mr. Thomas shared with the committee that the Board retreat would be this week and also shared the topics with them.
- There was discussion about how the committee wanted to move forward for the 2018-2019 school year.

## **Member Introductions:**

- It was suggested that TAC meet with the Principal Advisory Committee. Mr. Thomas stated that he would figure out how to get that set up.
- Committee members divided into groups to discuss topics.
- Committee members shared many important topics that their groups felt were important.
  - Achievement Closing the gap
  - Social and Emotional state of students
  - Staff Finding good quality staff
  - Micro teams/literacy Coach/GT Coaches members shared that investments in these areas are not helping kids.
- The four main topics that the committee will focus on moving forward are:
  - Discipline/Social and Emotional state of students
  - Literacy Achievement
  - Professional Development
  - o Staffing
- There was discussion among the committee about the next meeting and where to go from here.
- Mr. Thomas reminded the committee about being recognized at the Board meeting on October 30.
