I intend to remain in a Project GRAD High School (Fulton or Austin-East) until graduation. I also understand that after meeting the eligibility requirements for the Project GRAD Scholarship as outlined in this document, I will be eligible to receive a \$4,000 scholarship disbursed \$1,000 annually for up to four years at any accredited college, university, or post-secondary technical institution within the United States.

I understand that:

- all scholarship monies will be paid directly to the academic institution once enrollment is verified through proof of registration at the institution receiving my scholarship funding.
- scholarship recipients have five years from activation to claim the scholarship on a semester basis. The scholarship must be used continuously once awarded and fully exhausted within five (5) years of the date of high school graduation. In the event a student enlists for active duty in any branch of the United States Armed Forces and begins serving within the twelve (12) month period immediately following high school graduation, the student's eligibility for the scholarship under the Project GRAD Scholarship Program shall be extended. In no event, however, shall Project GRAD's obligation to provide scholarship funding extend beyond six (6) years after graduation, unless special circumstances warrant an exception, which shall be at Project GRAD's sole discretion.
- Scholarships must be renewed each semester. Each semester's renewal requires maintenance of a 2.0 grade point average or better and classification by credit hours of the academic institution as a full time student per semester at an accredited college, university, or post-secondary technical institution. Requirements of Partner Institutions may differ.

The \$4,000 Project GRAD scholarship disbursed \$1,000 annually for up to four years at any accredited college, university, or post-secondary technical institution within the United States. All scholarship monies will be paid directly to the academic institution once enrollment is verified through proof of registration at the institution receiving scholarship funding. Scholarship recipients have five years from activation to claim the scholarship on a semester basis.
