


Fountain City Elementary Safety and Security Reminders to all Pepcat families!

Entering the Building

- All parents and visitors MUST show their ID and state their name to office staff at the front door.
- Parents and guests MUST NOT enter the building behind a staff member or a student without showing his/her ID and stating their name for approval. No "piggybacking" entrance into the school.
- School Administration and Security reserve the right to approve or deny entrance to any individual.
- All parents and visitors must wear a VISITOR'S BADGE at all times.

Arrival of Students

- Students are to be dropped off on Montbelle Drive in the car rider line no earlier than 7:10am and must be supervised.
- Students are late if they are not in the classroom by
 7.45 a m
- Entrance for students is the Gym doors in the morning until 7:45 a.m. After 7:45 students and parents must buzz into the front office.

Pick-Up of Students

- Adults must have an ID and he/she must be on the child's emergency card to be allowed to pick up any student.
- In the car rider line, all adults MUST have a car rider name card from the school to pick up any student. If not, they must go to the office with an ID to sig out students.
- Adults picking up children in a car MUST follow the protocol for waiting until all 5 cars at the front of the line are loaded and the STOP sign is changed to SLOW.
- All NO PARKING areas are off limits.



Visitors on our campus who display loud or inappropriate behavior, causing concerns for students or staff, will be escorted from the building by security and possibly reported to the police.

Montbelle Drive Arrival and Dismissal Reminders

For the safety of every Precious Pepcat, please remember:

Never drop off students from across the street. You must use the car line to avoid placing your child in danger. Your child's safety is worth far more than any inconvenience this may cause you.

Safety Patrol students are on car duty at 7:20 AM. If you arrive at school before then, your child will exit the vehicle without staff assistance. After 7:20, please stay in the car line and wait for a student to open your door once you stop at a cone.

Adults should remain in vehicles. If you must walk to the building with your child, please park on Grove Dr. and escort your child to the entrance. To avoid congestion, do not park in our car line.

Avoid creating unnecessary delays in the line. Please prepare your child to exit the car promptly when a safety patrol member opens the door.

During both arrival and dismissal, please remain in the car line until all cars pull forward. When drivers impatiently pull out of the line, the line slows and chances of accidents increase dramatically. In the afternoon, a staff member is holding a "STOP" and "SLOW" sign to alert when the line can move.

Thank you for following these rules. Our staff values your time, but we value even more the safety of you children!

Civility Code for Knox County Schools (Policy B-230)

Expectations for all staff, students, parents, and guests:
