#### **Morning Drop Off**

Thank you so much for your patience as we work through our morning traffic. Here are a few tips that will help it run smoothly:

- Please have your child ready to exit your vehicle when you drive up.
- Students should exit and enter your vehicle on the passenger's side for safety reasons.
- We begin unloading students by 7:07. The traffic flows nicely until 7:29 then it becomes bogged down.
