I just wanted to remind everyone that ALL of Knox County Schools are going virtual for the week of December 14-18th. ALL students will be learning virtually for this final week of school before winter break. School hours are 7:45-2:45. PreK students will not be virtual. PreK teachers should have provided activities for our PreK children. Kindergarten classes will be a shortened day: 7:45-12:15. Teachers should have communicated with you about what learning will look like for your child. Learning may consist of synchronous or asynchronous instruction during this time. This includes Encore, ELL and special education services. Teachers will be available during this week through a variety of ways, email, class Dojo, etc... Please feel free to reach out to your child's teacher if you have any questions.

As a reminder, December 18th will be a half day and school classes will end at 11:15. There will be NO Encore classes on December 18th due to it being a half day of school. We will have food pick up on Monday and Wednesday from 9:00-10:00.
